I Important safety information

All of the necessary work must be performed by qualified persons with an appropriate level of expertise.



⚠ WARNING



- III Installation
- 1 Prepare vehicle
- Before starting work, check that the vehicle is free of defects. Use the PIWIS II system tester to read out all of the fault memories of the individual vehicle components and first rectify any faults displayed.

Please read the assembly instructions thoroughly and observe the specified procedure and instructions. Due to the technical complexity we recommend to let this installation to be carried out solely by an authorized partner. We can only grant guarantee if the installation has been done correctly according to the assembly instructions.

2 Preliminary work

2.1 Dismantle rear apron

- 1 Raise the vehicle at the factory-fitted jacking points.
- 2 Remove the rear wheels.
- 3 Turn the ignition on.
- 4 Extract the rear spoiler.
- 5 Turn the ignition off.
- 6 Disconnect the battery.

Carrera

7 Dismantle the cover right and left (1).

8 Remove the screws below the rear spoiler.

- 9 Remove the screws for the spoiler base frame.
- 10 Remove the base frame carefully over the spoiler supports.

11 Unscrew the strip lighting fixture (2), pull it out and separate both electrical connections.



- 12 Unscrew the taillight.
- 13 Unscrew the screws of the rear apron on the top.
- 14 Unscrew the screws of the rear apron in the wheel house.
- 15 Unscrew the screws of the rear apron on the bottom.
- 16 Separate the electrical connections of the rear apron in the area of the taillights.
- 17 Remove the rear apron towards the rear.

- 3 Install TECHART exhaust unit incl. wiring harness
- 3.1 Installation wiring harness

Coupé

1 Remove the rear linings in the inside.



Cabriolet

- 2 First, set the convertible top into service position. Then unhinge the steel cable for the window.
- 5 To dismantle the lining use a wedge to lift the lid.

9 Turbo und Turbo S, spoiler control unit.



All vehicles

- 10 Connect the CAN-wiring harness by unpinning Pin 3 (Carrera) or Pin1 (Turbo & Turbo S) from the plug and pin in the orange-black cable of the TECHART wiring harness.
- 11 Insert the unpinned cable into the supplied plug to position PIN 1.
- 12 Also unpin PIN 4 (Carrera) or Pin 2 (Turbo & Turbo S) and insert the orange-brown cable of the TECHART wiring harness into the free pin shaft.
- 13 Finally insert the unpinned cable into the supplied plug to position PIN 2.
- 14 Please note the following chart which can be used on several TECHART products.
- 15 Please refer to the table below when using several auxiliary control units.



- 16 Connect the brown cable of the TECHART wiring harness to the ground point at the body.
- 17 Pin the black cable of the TECHART wiring harness into a free place of the fuse carrier battery positive (permanent power supply) and insert the fuse A5.

- 18 Lock the plug of the spoiler control unit again.
- 19 Connect the 2-pole TECHART plug with the TECHART wiring harness. Pay attention that the plug snaps in correctly.

3.2 Installation TECHART rear muffler

1 Dismantle air duct.

2 Dismantle crossmember with heat protection.



3 Loosen the clamps of the exhaust unit and push towards the outer side of the vehicle.



- 4 Unplug both plugs of the exhaust unit (1) and loosen the straps at the exhaust muffler (2).
- 5 Remove the rear muffler.
- 6 Remove the straps. They are no longer needed.



7 Route the wiring harness from the rear left to the right side and from there to exhaust unit below. Make sure that the cable is protected from rotating and hot parts and that it is fastened correctly.

Carry out the following steps on both sides:

- 8 Pull the ventilation hose out of the guide.
- 9 Guide the end of the hose down through the gap.

- 10 Bring the corrugated pipe into shape as shown in the picture.
- 11 Connect the free end of the hose to the hose connector and the corrugated pipe.
- 12 It is not necessary to remove the funnel and the hose, but it may simplify the assembly.



- 13 Fasten the TECHART rear muffler with the clamps at the outlet of the catalytic converters.
- 14 Align the TECHART rear muffler in the center then tighten the clamps. Tightening torque 30Nm.



- 15 Pull the heat protection over the cable which are routed to the exhaust flap.
- 16 Connect the TECHART wiring harness with both exhaust flaps at the TECHART rear muffler.
- 17 Tighten the lock of the plugs.



18 Fasten the corrugated pipes with the enclosed stainless steel cable ties to the plugs together with the heat protection.



19 Fasten the muffler with the clamps on the original muffler.



- 20 Install the crossmember with the heat protection.
- 21 Connect the rear apron and the lamps electrically and install in reverse order.
- 22 Reconnect the battery.
- 23 Read out the fault memories and if necessary, rectify the faults displayed. After this complete the vehicle.
- 24 Start the vehicle and check the functions.
- 25 Reinstall the remaining parts in reverse order.
